The Town of Kershaw (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

Hanging Rock Creek WWTP Phase 2 Improvements

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Kershaw Town Hall** located at **113 S. Hampton Street, Kershaw, SC 29067**, until **Tuesday, May 13, 2025** at **2:00pm** local time. At that time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Replacement of pump motors and associated piping in the Influent Pump Station, installation of a mechanical bar screen, associated electrical and instrumentation work, as well as alternates involving the Sequencing Batch Reactor replacing diffused air units.

This project is being funded in whole or in part by the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) and by the SC Rural Infrastructure Authority (RIA). All federal CDBG and South Carolina state RIA requirements will apply to the contract. The prime contractor is required to be registered in the federal System for Award Management (SAM). Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 & Order No. 11375 which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240, and Build America, Buy America Act (BAP), imposed by the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA), enacted under Division G, Title IX of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA, Pub. L. No. 117-58) signed into law on November 15, 2021. The CDBG application, including the cost estimate, is available for review by contacting Christine Schwartz cschwartz@catawbacog.org.

Bidders must also make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned business and to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

The owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities, or to reject any or all bids.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 (ninety) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
