Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the City of York City Hall located at 10 N. Roosevelt St., York, South Carolina, until **Friday, September 25th at 10:00 AM** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

As part of the project, the current station will remain in place during construction. The upgrades to the system will include a new influent gravity sewer into the wet well, new pumps, piping, and appurtenances will be placed withing the existing wet well but, a new valve vault structure will be installed. The project will also involve the installation of a new electrical system, controls, and an on-site emergency generator. Additionally, the site will gain a curb cut from Hwy 321 to the driveway, to improve access and maintenance for City staff. California Street pump station will also receive new pumps and electrical components as a part of this project.

Pre-bid Conference

A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **Wednesday, September 9th at 2:00 PM at York City Hall, 10 N. Roosevelt St. York, South Carolina 29745**. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged but not required.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid security shall be submitted with each bid in the amount of 5 percent of the total bid amount. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 calendar days after opening of bids. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities.

No proposal will be considered unless it is accompanied by satisfactory evidence that the Bidder holds either a South Carolina State Contractor's License, South Carolina State Utility Contractor's License, or qualifications with the South Carolina Department of Transportation for similar work, in compliance with

Act. O.C.G.A. 43-14 and 43-41. Failure to provide the bidder's license or qualification number on the outside of the sealed proposal will result in rejection of the bid.

If the Contract is to be awarded, Owner will award the Contract on the basis of the base bid plus selected alternatives.

Successful bidder shall begin the Work on receipt of the Notice to Proceed and shall complete the Work within the Contract Time of 360 calendar days. Owner shall make progress payments on account of the Contract Price on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment submitted once per month as provided in the General Conditions.

Bidders must make positive efforts to use small and minority owned businesses.

Bidders must comply with 41 CFR 60-4, in regard to affirmative action, to ensure equal opportunity to females and minorities and will apply the timetables and goals set forth in 41 CFR 60-4.

Bidders must comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended, prohibiting discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin; Title VI of the Civil Rights Acts of 1964; the Davis-Bacon Act; the Anti-Kickback Act; and the Contract Work Hours Standards Act.

This project is funded, in part, by **South Carolina Rural Infrastructure Authority Economic Infrastructure Program.**

Grantees are required to comply with an amendment to the SC Code of Laws enacted by the General Assembly and effective June 30, 2026 as follows:
